Reviewing Your Ballot

After you have finished marking your ballot, please look over your ballot to make sure it is voted the way you want. Make sure that you check the back of the ballot for propositions.

If you would like to review your ballot on the voting machine, prior to inserting your ballot in the scanner; you must tell the Inspector at the voting machine that you would like to review your ballot.

The Voting Machine Inspector will then set up the machine for you to review your ballot on the Administrative Menu Screen to your right. Use the "Next" and "Previous" buttons on the screen to toggle between screens. When you are done reviewing and are satisfied, you may press the Green Cast button and your ballot will be voted. If you need to make any changes press the Red Return button, then return your ballot to the table where you signed in and receive a new ballot.

Scanning Your Ballot

Insert your ballot into the scanner. If there are no errors, the voting machine will cast your ballot after it has scanned. The screen to your right will read "Ballot Successfully Cast".
